Restrictions: Single adult applicants or families with adults only are not eligible Client cannot be receiving a hamper from any other source Client may only receive a hamper from this program once every 3 years. (Eligible again on the fourth year)
- Made By Momma Christmas Programs A Social Worker referral is required from an agency where the applicant is actively involved with agency programming. Referrals open from October until one week before Christmas (exceptions can be made).
