IPP Accommodation Supports for Online Instruction

GENERAL ACCOMMODATIONS

Because many IPP related supports/accommodations are site-based, we are advocating that IPP students who require extra help consider making use of the following accommodations that should help facilitate online work:

Assignment Deadline Extension

Teacher and student negotiate a reasonable deadline for task completion, given student ability and overall workload.

Assignment Adaptation

Assignment Adaptation means revising assignments in a manner that makes them more accessible to the student while still allowing the student to demonstrate grade-level competencies. (Different from "Assignment Modification", which means moving off of grade level. This would have to be negotiated between teacher/family/Student Services).

Assignment Forgiveness

Reducing number of expected assignments and/or eliminating specific tasks.

STUDENT STRATEGIES

Self-Advocacy:

- -contact teachers if/when clarification/explanation is required
- -think about what it is specifically that may be confusing for you and frame questions for teachers around that realization

Organization:

- -Create a daily planner / work timetable to focus work and to divide it up during the week (perhaps based on the actual school's timetable?)
- -"Chunk" assignments into smaller parts
- -Focus on work that you know you can complete first and compile a list of questions to ask your teacher for help with later

Self-Regulation

- -Take regular breaks to maintain focus and energy
- -Recognize moments of frustration and allow time for reflection and refocus
- -Ensure proper rest, exercise and nutrition
